Thank you for agreeing to conduct a peer review which will help us decide whether a manuscript is to be published in the *European Journal of Risk Regulation* (EJRR).

The following guidelines are designed to help you in your evaluation, bearing in mind the journal's criteria:

- *Be courteous:* The purpose of the review process is to enable the author to learn from your comments, questions and corrections. If you are too harsh in your critique, the author may well not 'hear' it.
- *Be precise and specific:* Make sure all your comments can be properly incorporated by the author, for example: 'The article would gain in relevance if case x was included in the analysis in paragraph 1'; or: 'The analysis of case x would improve if the point made by Y in her article in EJRR issue no. ... was included'.
- *Strive to use positive phrasing throughout:* Comments should be presented in a constructive manner, even if significant improvements are required.
