

## CALL FOR PAPERS

The **European Competition and Regulatory Law Review (CoRe)** provides a practical and intellectual forum to discuss, comment and review all issues raised by the development and implementation of the law and policy governing the area of general and sector-specific competition law in the 28 EU Member States.

### Content and Form

Contributors to the journal report on key legislative developments in the EU and the Member States, and analyse important judgments that shape the field of EU competition and regulatory law, in particular those by the European Courts, international courts and tribunals, and higher national courts. For the issues of **CoRe** in 2018, we welcome submissions of **articles**, **case notes**, **country reports** and **book reviews** on, but not limited to, the following topics:

- Major ongoing antitrust matters (eg Google, Gazprom) and procedural trends (commitment cases with behavioral/structural remedies, settlement cases);
- EU and national antitrust enforcement in network industries;
- Consultation of procedural and jurisdictional aspects of EU merger control;
- Tax ruling investigations;
- Digital Single Market Strategy and competition rules (e-commerce regulation and sector inquiry, Electronic Communications Code, big data and antitrust, broadband rollout, roaming tariffs, net neutrality etc);
- Directive 2014/104/EU on antitrust damages actions.

All contributions will be subject to double blind peer-review before acceptance for publication and are required to conform to the author guidelines available at: [www.lexxion.eu/core/author-guidelines](http://www.lexxion.eu/core/author-guidelines)
