This is to give you some useful information about publishing in the European Food and Feed Law Review (EFFL). **Please fill in also the form at the end of the document.**

**Format:**

- All contributions should be in **MS-Word**. **Articles** use **footnotes** for citation but not a list of references; **Country reports** usually do not have footnotes.
- **Articles** should have between 18,000 and 30,000 **characters** including blanks. There should be an **abstract** at the beginning (approximately 1000 **characters** including blanks). **Country reports** should have between 2500 and 5000 **characters** including blanks. Please contact the managing editor if your contribution is shorter or longer.
- Reports about **jurisdiction** should name the court, the date and the file number as a heading; if the decision is not self-explanatory, a short **explanation** should follow the decision.

**Content:**

- **Articles** focus on a specific issue with a scientific approach.
- **Country reports** cover recent developments in the Member States.

**Review/Acceptance of Articles:**

- All contributions are reviewed by the managing editor; they can forward contributions to external experts for an additional review.
- The publication of any contribution can be rejected for publication by the managing editor without giving any reason; but the managing editor will first give an author the chance to improve the contribution before rejecting it for publication.

**Rights:**

- All rights are owned by the publishers, Lexxion ; if you want to publish your contribution additionally in any other medium other than EFFL, please contact the managing editor or the publishers, Lexxion, in advance.

**Revision:**

- Before printing you will receive proofs of your contribution for revision and a free sample of the issue after printing.
